

Changing Room Use Guidelines

Club changing rooms are provided for members use and occasional use of guests at special events. The club has about 500 members and at times the changing room can see very high levels of use so it is important to keep them clean and clear.

Members are asked to abide by the following guidelines to ensure everyone has good use of the changing rooms.

- No personal property (incl. sports equipment) should be left in the changing rooms on long term basis (> 2 days)
- Items that have been left for more than 2 days are assumed to be 'lost' and members may move them to the lost property buckets placed on top of the lockers in the upper corridor.
- Items not recovered from lost property buckets within approximately 2 weeks may be disposed of, as appropriate to the item in question.
- Wet river clothing may be left during the day on the drying racks in the shower areas but should be removed by the end of the day.
- Especially during busy periods please use shelves provided for bags
- Wet users should ensure they clear up any mud or water carried in from the river.

Exceptions to these guidelines must be agreed with your Captain and advised accordingly. One approved exception is the safety clothing located in the corner of the Womens Changing room (DryRobe and bag of dry towels)
